

Rockcliffe Newsletter 6 - Autumn Term


Dear Rockcliffe Families,

Pupil Leadership Team

As we continue to Rock, as part of developing being responsible, our Year 4's have been allocated their Pupil Leadership roles for this year. Pupil participation involves creating a culture where all children and young people have a voice and the chance to actively influence decisions related to their learning and wellbeing, as outlined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). We believe that establishing proper structures is essential so that all pupils can participate in decision-making. As the leaders of

the future, all of our Year 4 children are encouraged to embrace a wide range of leadership opportunities, helping them to grow as successful learners, confident individuals and responsible citizens, who shape and develop the school as a whole.



Our Pupil Leadership Team is comprised of nine expert learning teams, whose roles and responsibilities are to:

- Act as an ambassador for the school both in and out
- Represent pupil voice
- Work alongside the subject leader to continue to improve teaching and learning in their area
- Assist the subject leader to plan, organise and run events to promote their area
- Help the governors to make decisions on behalf of the pupils
- Meet regularly to provide feedback to the senior leadership team and governors about key decisions.

In addition we have introduced all Year 4 pupils taking a turn at doing lunch duty, helping dinner staff to support younger children in the dinner hall and leading activities in the yard. They have been brilliant so far this year.



Our Children's Takeover Day later in the year will provide an opportunity to work alongside adults in school to support daily activities and fulfil vital tasks to audit, evaluate and raise the profile of their subjects or area of school-life.
